

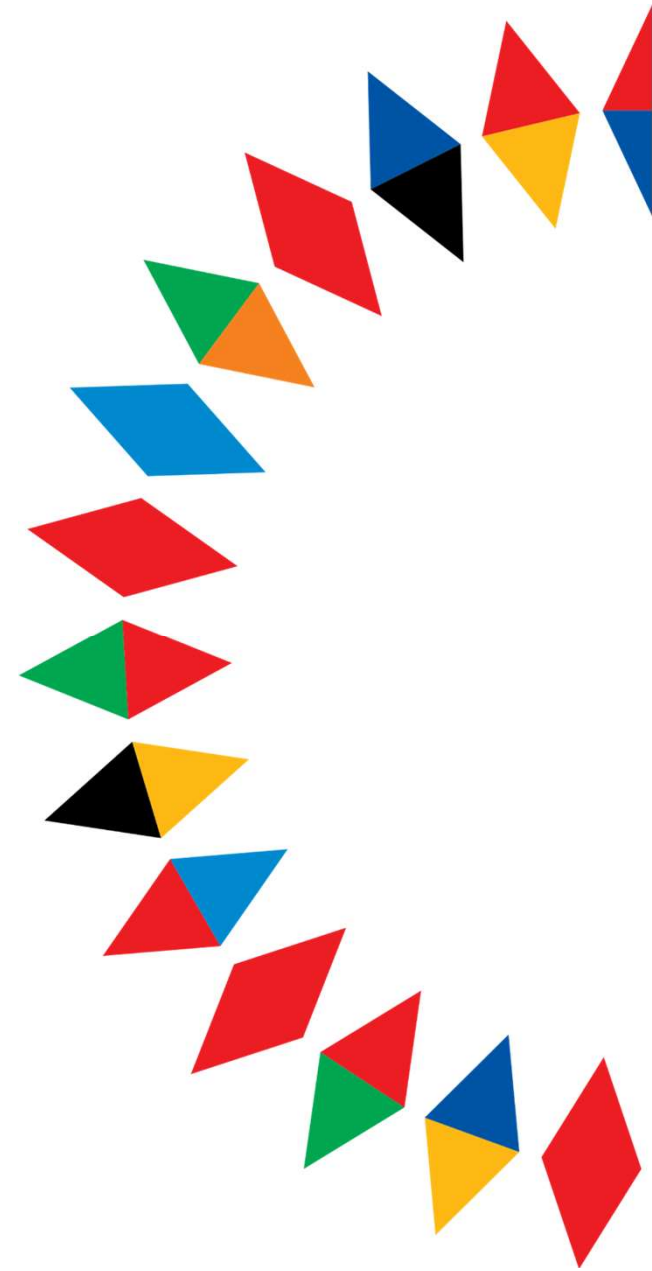

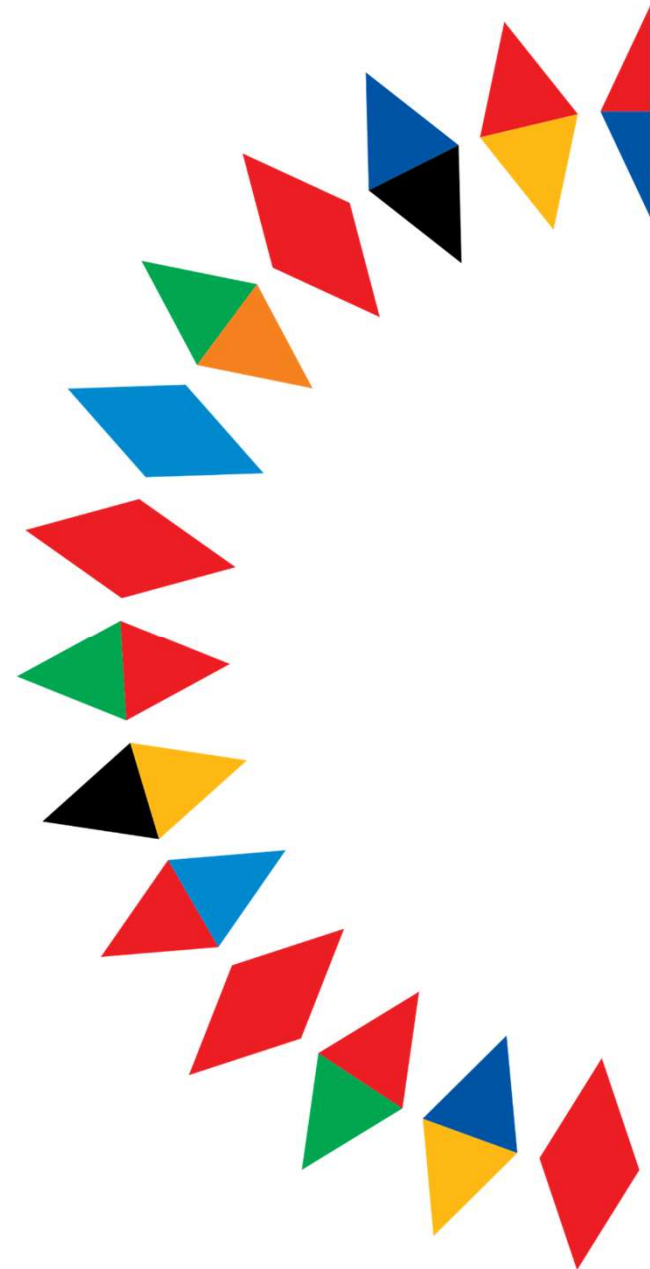
Importance of definition LTEs

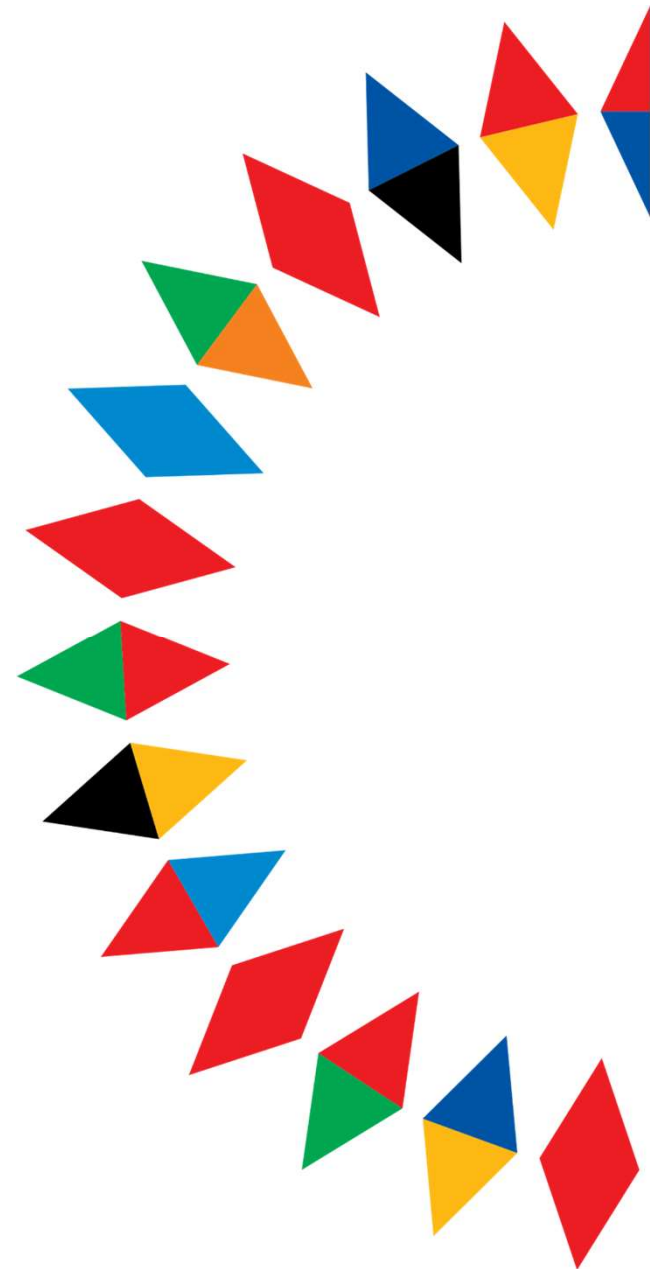

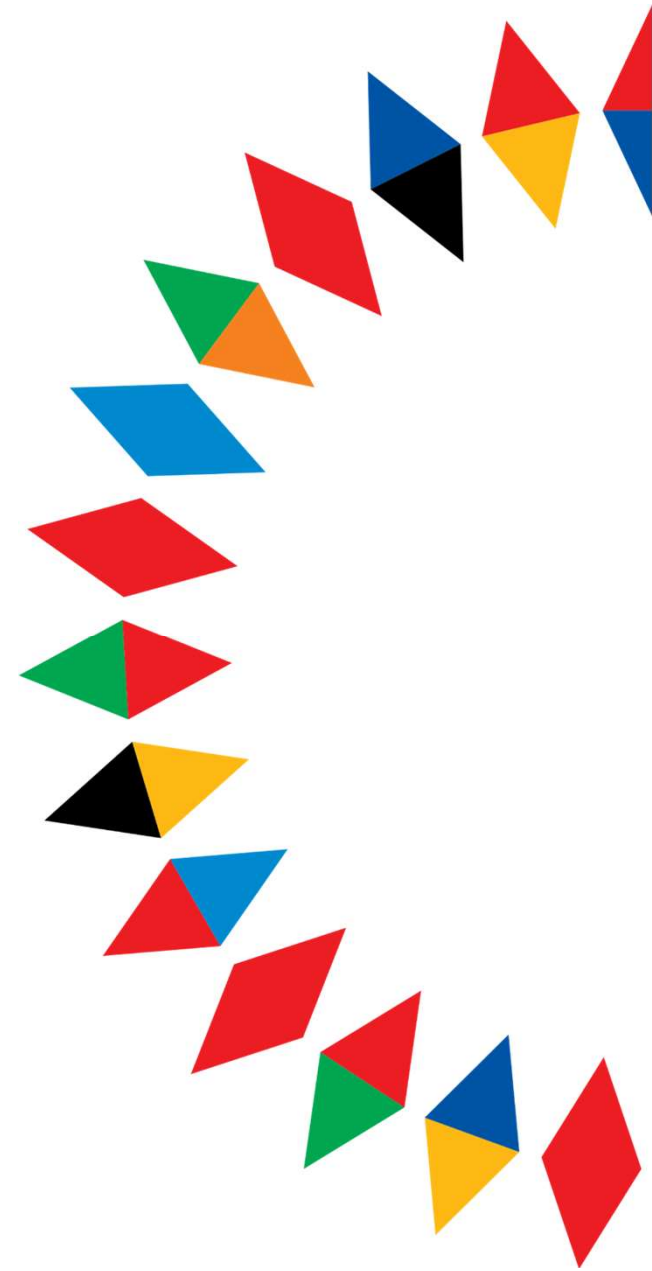
Two types of LTEs

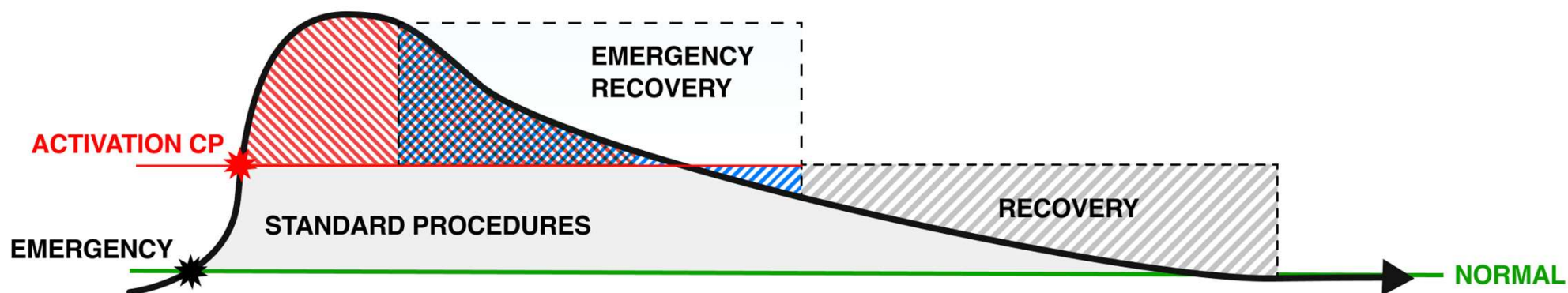

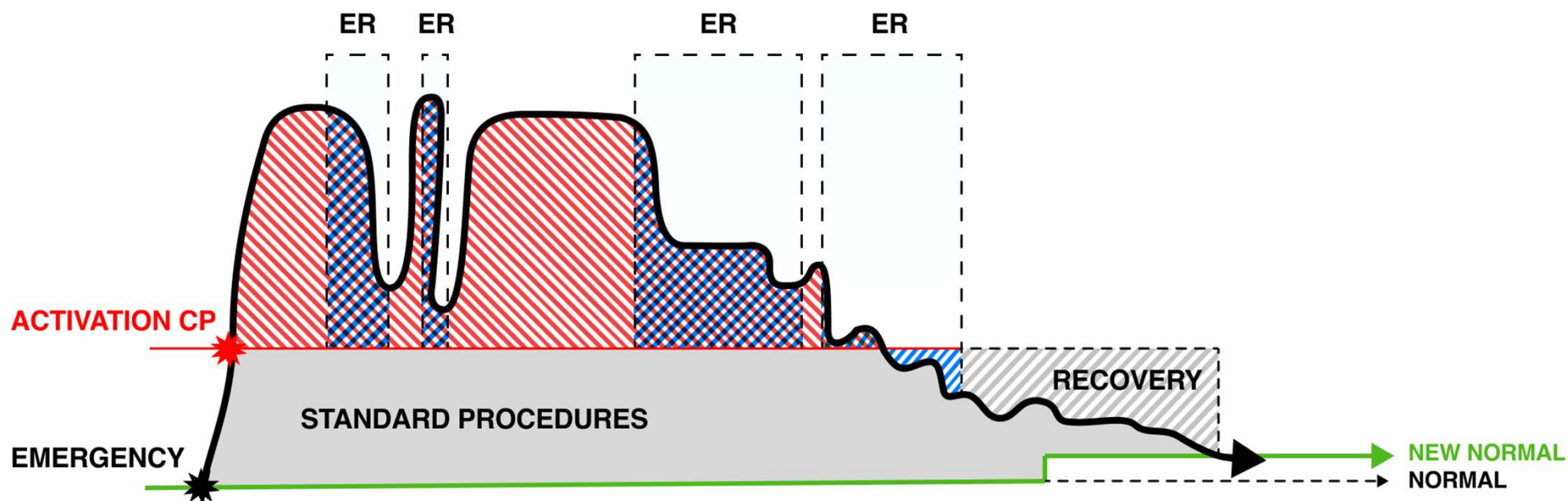

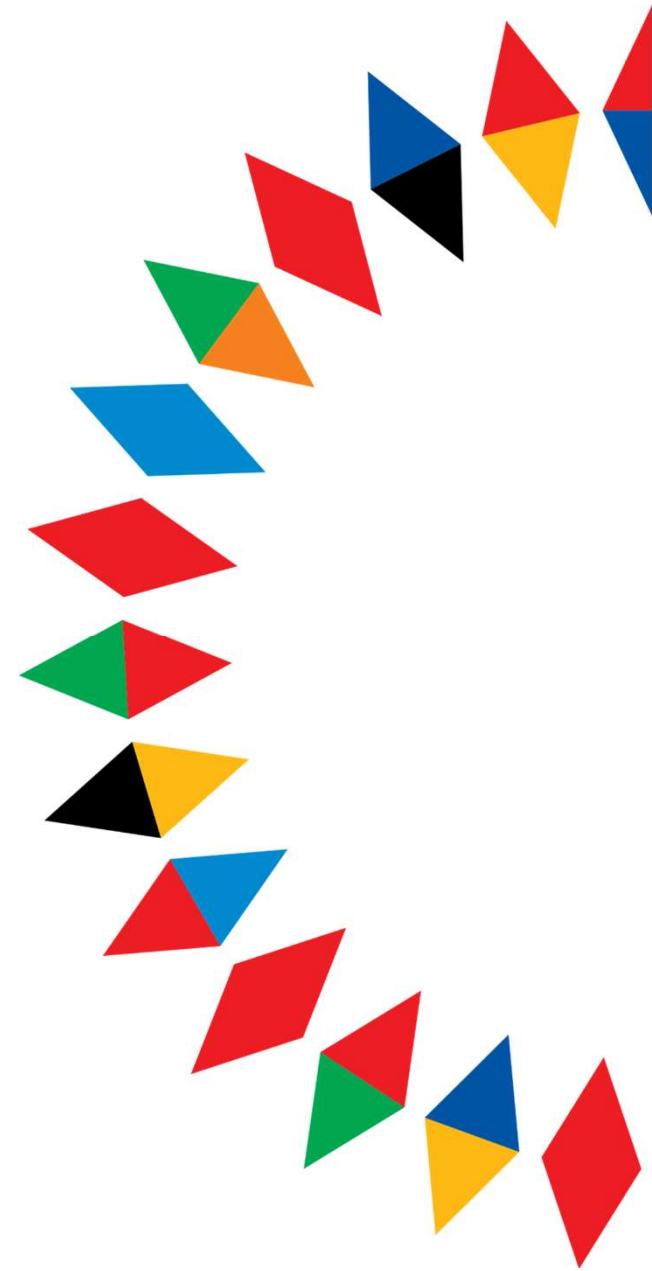

- Unclear end or peak of emergency



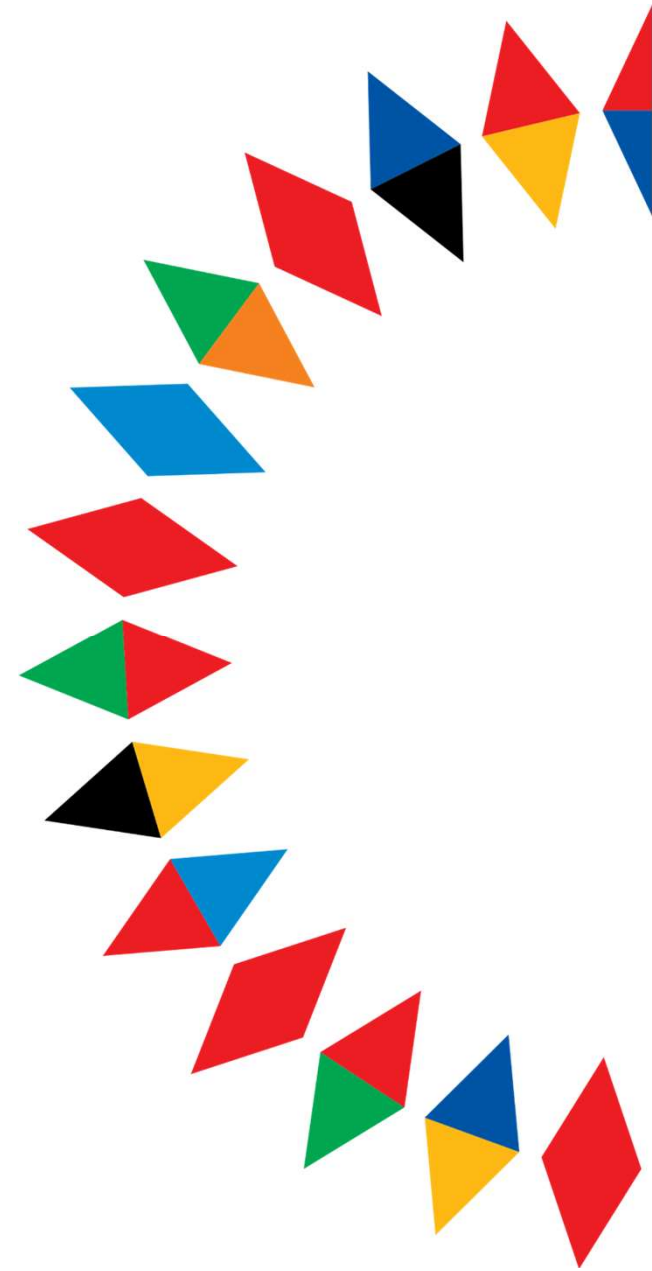
Common elements

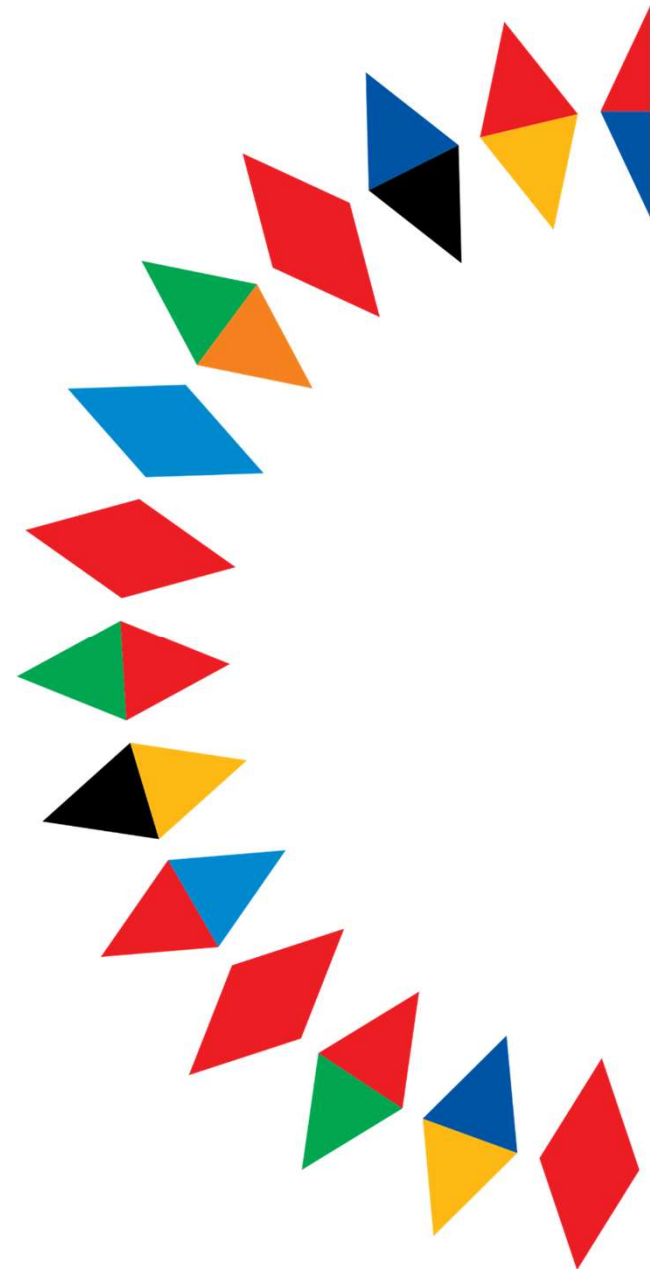

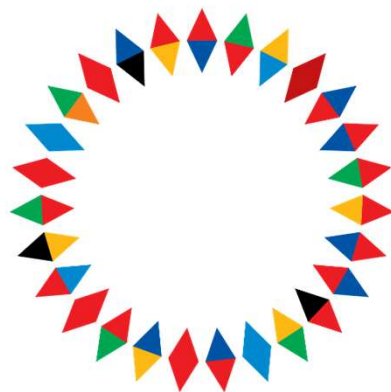
